# Keynote Speaker

**Hon. Dr. Roberto Fulcar** Minister of Education Dominican Republic

Hon. Dr. Roberto Fulcar is the Minister of Education, Dominican Republic. He is doctorate and a thesis professor at various universities in the Dominican Republic, including Nova Southeastern University, USA. Dr. Fulcar has published globally on topics relating to education and politics in addition to being a renowned social activist, having organized unions, human rights, and academic and cultural institutions. Dr. Fulcar is a frequent keynote speaker, strategic planner, researcher, evaluator, and a Lead Quality Systems auditor.

#### **Education for Better Living: A New Social Contract for Education**

The COVID 19 pandemic laid bare the obsolescence of the old educational models. The evidence that they are incapable of generating quality education or positively impacting the lives of individuals and societies is sufficiently robust. The Dominican Republic does not escape this reality. On the contrary, it invariably fails in international measurements on the matter, occupying terrible places in the ranking of the community of nations.

The present management of pre-university education in the country promotes a new educational model, which has been called *Education for Better Living: A New Social Contract for Education*. Based on the 12 pillars, this academic proposal is based on the idea that education cannot continue to be a naïve and unintentional activity given to us in life as a natural thing such as eating, dressing, interacting etc. On the contrary, it must be intentionality oriented and directed to improve the life of people and societies.

The strategic purpose of this model promoted by the Government of Dominican Republic is to train its citizens comprehensively, and endow them with the skills needed to integrate effectively into the society and contribute to its transformation. They should also have values to live together in solidarity, be assertive, resilient and maintain a culture of piece, contributing to the sustained development and well-being of their country and humanity.

# **Hon. Er. Francisco Camacho**Minister of Sports Dominican Republic

Hon. Er. Francisco Camacho is the Minister of Sports, Dominican Republic. He is a renowned and successful sports leader who has chaired the Dominican Taekwondo Federation since 2007, and institution that, under his guidance, has given the country two of its twelve Olympics medals. Minister Camacho has also been a national and international trainer. In addition, Minister Camacho has been a member of the executive committee of the Dominican Olympic Committee. Indeed, Hon. Camacho has been recognized as an advocate of athletes' rights to a quality higher education and sports entrepreneurship.

# School Sports as a Basis for Sociocultural and Economic Transformation: INDOMITA-RD

Our societies' rapid and profound changes demand new orientations in sports and educational goals. Sport is fundamental in the evolution of society and an element of social cohesion that reduces economic, cultural, racial, religious, and social differences. School sport emerges as one of the essential elements in the social and economic development of people since it has a direct relationship with the development of the individual and society based on values, social and moral integration, fundamental elements for the growth of the individual, especially in this age of knowledge.

In order to implement school sports a reality, the new Government of Dominican Republic created the INDOMITA-RD project, in charge of the development of School Sports, Neighborhood Sports Initiation, and Community and Diaspora Sports in all its aspects.

INDOMITA-RD, through the relaunch of school sports, unites the school with the Community Sports Centers, the sports courts, and the community of the neighborhood/place, supporting sports initiation and physical activity in the country of diaspora.
